 - *Reviews of safeguarding of care and any immediate issues requiring action now, including, but not limited to freedom to speak up arrangements, advocacy provision, complaints, CETRs and ICETRs, and other feedback on services*

 - *Feedback to the national team regarding the inpatient quality programme run by Liz Durrant*
