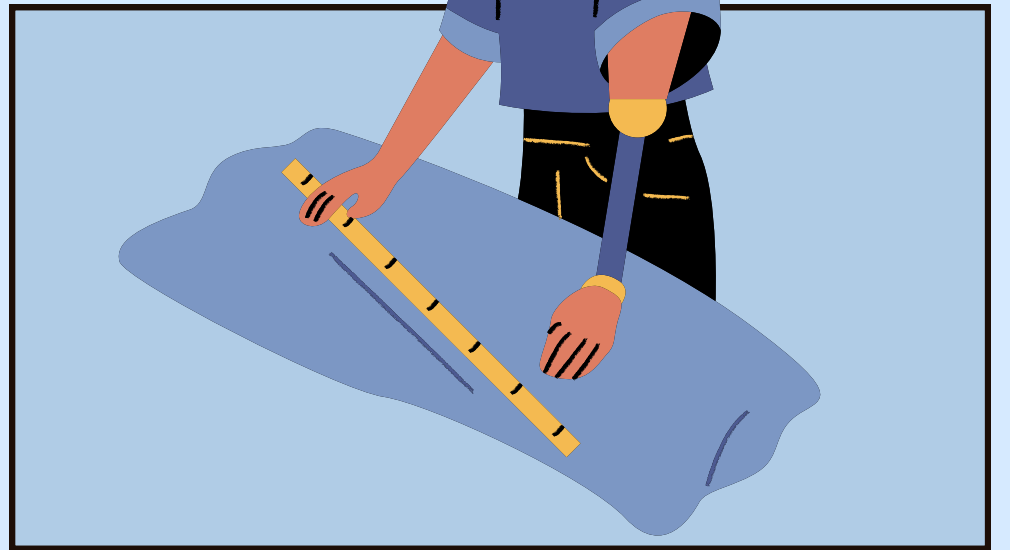


# Prosthetist

## Patient Reported Experience Measure 2024



During the week of the 11th November 2024 Prosthetists across the trust asked all patients that they had contact with to complete a profession specific experience measure.

This asked patients about their understanding of the profession, their views of the profession's role in their care and recovery, the impact of this profession's interventions, what they valued about the profession and their recommendations for the profession for the future.



**100%** of patients asked knew what the role of a prosthetist was.

**100%** of patients knew how a prosthetist could support with their recovery and wellbeing.
