Request for Information

I write further to your request FOI ID 47815 under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding: -

Board and senior management reviews and action plans of all homicides 2018-2022

Your request is set out below:

1. Board (and associated Committees) and Senior Management Review of all homicides committed by service users whilst under Trust care between 2018 and 2022.
2. Board (and associated Committees) and Senior Management Review of the action plans relating to homicides committed by service users whilst under Trust care between 2018 and 2022.
3. Board (and associated Committees) and Senior Management Review monitoring of the action plans relating to all homicides committed by service users whilst under Trust care between 2018 and 2022.

The Trust monitors the implementation of action plans developed in response to report and recommendations relating to mental health homicides. In addition, the lead mental health commissioner, Kent and Medway ICB also monitor how the Trust is implementing recommendations.

Given that our reviews and action plans are case specific the majority of these contain information which would be deemed personal data as defined by the Data Protection Act 2018. As a result, we are not obliged to release this data in line with section 40 (2) FOIA, as to do so would contravene principles of the DPA.

As a result, please find attached copies of information we are able to provide.
