- Entrants under the age of 16 must have permission from a parent or guardian.

2. How to Enter

- Submit up to three (3) original photographs by email to: kmpt.communications@nhs.net
- Each entry must include:
 - Photographer's full name
 - Title or short caption for each photo
 - Location where the photo was taken
- Deadline for entries: Monday 8 September 2025 at midnight.
- Images must be submitted in JPEG format, with a resolution of 300 DPI or higher to ensure quality for printing.

3. Entry Guidelines

- Photos should reflect nature, calm, hope, or local beauty in Kent or Medway.
- If the entrant in under 16 entries must be submitted by a parent or guardian.
- All images must be the original work of the entrant.
- Entries must not include any offensive, harmful, or inappropriate content.
- Entries must not include people.
- By submitting your photo, you confirm that you have the permission of any identifiable features in the image.

4. Judging and Prizes

- Entries will be judged by a panel made up of KMPT staff and people with lived experience.
- Judging will take place between **9 and 16 September 2025**.
- Winners will be notified by 30 September.
- Judges will consider:
 - Relevance to theme
 - Emotional impact
 - Composition and clarity
- Selected entries will be printed and displayed on the garden fencing of the new health-based Place of Safety, due to open in April 2026.
- Winning photographers will be credited and invited to an unveiling celebration. Date of the unveiling will be confirmed.

5. Copyright and Usage

- Entrants will retain full copyright of their photos.
- By entering, you grant KMPT a non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to:
 - Use your images for the competition
 - Display them at the Health-Based Place of Safety and other facilities
 - Use them in promotional materials (e.g. social media, websites, reports)
- KMPT will always credit the photographer where possible when photos are used.
- The images can be used indefinitely.

6. Data Protection

• Any personal information you provide will be used only for the competition and in line with KMPT's privacy policy.

• We will not share your details with third parties without your consent.

7. General

- KMPT reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition or these terms if necessary.
