This is the cost of all printing in Communications. We cannot guarantee that all of these costs are related to printing healthcare communications, we do not have sufficient data to separate out costs of printing healthcare communications from other types of printing e.g. printing papers for meetings. Similarly, we do not have data to isolate the cost of printing healthcare communications which may have been generated by individual departments e.g. wards may print copies of information in other languages to support patients but this cannot be isolated from other types of printing.

8. Please provide the name of the person responsible for managing the creation of healthcare information communications?

The creation of healthcare information communications are managed by the Trust's in-house Communications and Engagement Team.

9. Does the trust offer in-hospital way-finding or signage in any language other than English?

Not as standard but would do so if required or requested.
