CYMPHS/CAMHS in the last five years

Your request is set out below:

How many children (under18) have been referred to CYMPHS/CAMHS in the last five years. [Between April 6 - April 5]?

Can you provide the total number of children referred for each year; 2019/2020, 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23 and 2023/24.

For each year, can you provide the number of children referred broken down by primary cause (such as, anxiety, depression etc.)

For children referred this year alone (Between April 6 - April 5 2023/24), how many received treatment?

Between April 6 - April 5 2023/24, how many referrals to CAMHS were either deemed inappropriate or rejected?

Between April 6 - April 5 2023/24, what was the average and maximum waiting times for CAMHS treatments from referral to first appointment?

Between April 6 - April 5 2023/24, how many CAMHS patients were sectioned?

As of September 2024, how many children and adolescents are on the waiting list for CAMHS?
