“Locums” is defined here as medical staff who have worked additional hours within the trust, usually in addition to a substantive contract or occasionally as part of an internal bank system. All locums are paid in accordance with trust terms and conditions, via our internal payroll.

“Private beds” includes all costs associated with the provision of the bed, including additional nursing costs, but excludes all costs associated with transport to/from the placement.
