Request for Information

I write further to your request FOI ID 48942 under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding: -

Parking Fines

Your request is set out below:

Based on your latest available data, how many fines have been handed out to members of staff at your Trust in 2024 for issues related to car parking? This could include parking in the wrong area, not having a permit etc.

If possible, please provide data broken down by calendar month. Spreadsheet format preferred if possible.

The trusts car parks are managed by an external company who hold the data in relation to the number of fines handed out for issues relating to parking.

As all car parks are for mixed use i.e. staff and members of the public it is not possible for the central data to be broken down into staff or public. This would require a manual exercise to review records and would exceed the appropriate time limits, as per the Freedom of Information Act 2000 section 12(1) which does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit.

I confirm that the information above completes your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I am also pleased to confirm that no charge will be made for this request.
